Through creative thinking, a commitment to excellence and a desire to innovate and transform, BGU is breaking down traditional barriers and creating a dynamic learning environment. For several consecutive years, BGU has been voted 'Best Place to Study' by a survey commissioned through the National Union of Israeli Students Research Department. BGU hosts 21,000 students at its three campuses in Be'er Sheva, Sde Boker and Eilat and serves as a bridge between academia and industry, and between Israel and the developing world. It has never viewed itself as an ivory tower and encourages students and faculty alike to be involved in the community. Approximately 600 Bedouin students along with another 900 Israeli Arab students, now attend BGU.
